⌘ Goal is to Reach 300 Girls:

1. Girls are exposed to fields where women can be leaders and where women are underrepresented across our state and nation (politics, science, technology and math). Girls are challenged to consider how they can be a leader in their circle of influence.
2. Girls have the opportunity to be ambassador's for their school by establishing "take action" after-school clubs around 1) **S.T.E.M** 2) **LEGO TECHNOLOGY**; 3) **FOREVER GREEN COMMUNITY ACTION**; and 4) **HEALTHY LIVING**.
3. Girls meet mentors (women leaders) who have made strides in STEM fields, politics and community leadership. Ensuring a common motivational message that girls CAN achieve success and be leaders in these fields and in their community.
